FIRE CODE ENFORCEMENT INSPECTOR

The City of Waukesha is accepting applications for the position of Fire Code Enforcement Inspector. This is a responsible inspection and code enforcement position that works with the Fire Prevention Bureau. Work involves inspection of new/existing structures, issuance of notices, citations, and related plans review work. Work is performed under the supervision of the Fire Marshall or the Assistant Chief. Work is performed independently and employees are expected to exercise judgment and discretion in carrying out assigned activities. Work is characterized by a high degree of responsibility for fire inspection and code enforcement activities necessitating considerable technical expertise.

Minimum requirements: High School diploma or equivalent, valid driver's license with excellent driving record, and Wisconsin Commercial Building Inspector License or Wisconsin Fire Inspector I certification. (Wisconsin Commercial Building Inspector License and Wisconsin Tank Inspector License required within one year from start of employment.) Minimum of four (4) years of experience in Municipal Code Enforcement or Fire Service (prevention or suppression activities). Associate degree in a Fire Science Program or a related field or an Apprenticeship in a related field preferred. Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen, psychological suitability exam, and criminal background check.

Salary range starts at \$57,017; maximum \$76,972 achieved through merit increases.
